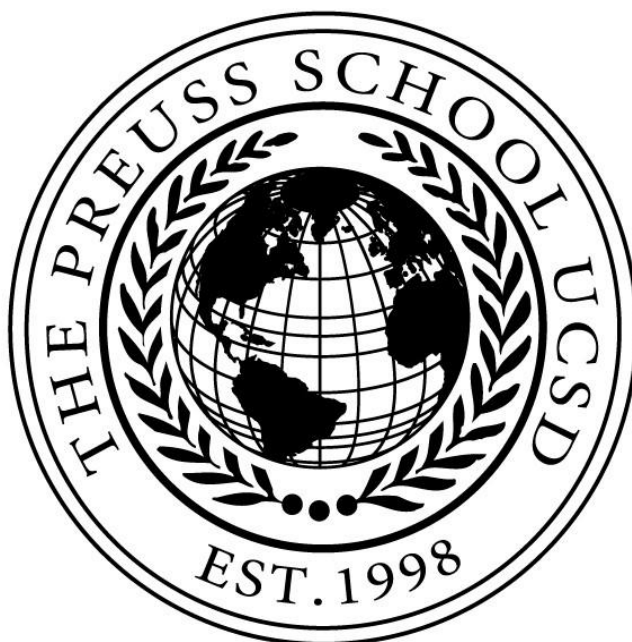


Mission Statement

The Preuss School UCSD is an intensive middle and high school chartered under the San Diego Unified School District and located on the University of California, San Diego campus in La Jolla. The mission of the Preuss School is to improve educational practices and provide an intensive college preparatory school for low-income student populations, which are historically underrepresented on the campuses of the University of California.

Admission to the Preuss School is on a nonsectarian basis, and does not discriminate against any pupil on the basis of ethnicity, special needs, national origin, gender, religion, sexual orientation or disability.

What is The Preuss School UCSD?

The Preuss School UCSD is an intensive college preparatory middle and high school located on the University of California, San Diego campus in La Jolla. The curriculum is rigorous, with classes starting at 8:55am and ending at 4:00pm. The school year is longer, from Mid-August through the end of June. Students are required to wear a uniform.

Is transportation available?

Bus transportation is currently provided from several areas within the San Diego Unified School District boundaries. However, school bus transportation is **not guaranteed**. If Preuss cannot provide transportation, the responsibility falls to the parents to make arrangements for student transportation to and from school. It is anticipated that the Trolley will come to Preuss in the future. If you have questions about transportation please call (858) 658-7412.

Who can apply?

The Preuss School UCSD will recruit and enroll students entering the **6th, 7th, 8th and 9th** grade from the greater San Diego area. Applicants must meet **all** three requirements in order to be eligible to attend the school, both at the time of application as well as at enrollment.

- The parents or chief guardians are NOT graduates of a four year-college or university.
- Student applicants must demonstrate motivation and potential to attend an academically competitive university or college.

How should I complete the application?

Please print **ONLY** in black or dark blue ink and write in the space provided (DO NOT use pencil or write in cursive handwriting). Typed answers or answers written on separate sheets of paper will NOT be accepted. Parent(s), guardian(s), the applicant, and recommending teachers have sections to complete. Students with an I.E.P., 504 or special needs may utilize accommodations and modifications to complete sections in accordance with their individualized education programs.

What is the Admission Process?

Students who meet all three requirements and wish to attend The Preuss School UCSD must complete the provided application in its entirety. We may request a student interview. Since there will be more applicants than space available at The Preuss School UCSD, a lottery of qualified applicants will be held to select the students for the number of available spaces. Those who are placed in the lottery but are not selected will be placed on a waiting list. Students on the waiting list will be considered if a space becomes available. Please note, applying to The Preuss School does not guarantee admission.

What if the applicant has a brother/sister attending The Preuss School UCSD?

Candidates for admission are considered individually, with no preference extended to brothers/sisters of current students. Parents applying for an additional child must be up to date with their required service hours for their current Preuss child in order for this application to be processed. Parents are required to complete 15 hours of service to the school for one child and an additional 10 hours per additional child each school year.

By February 3, 2012: parents with one current Preuss student need to complete at least 7.5 hours; parents with two current Preuss students need to complete at least 12.5 hours and parents with three current Preuss students need to complete at least 17.5 hours.

If a student is accepted, parents must complete the total annual requirement by the end of the 2011-2012 school year. If a parent does not complete the total annual requirement, admission will be denied. For questions regarding volunteer hours, please call (858) 658-7473.

Does The Preuss School UCSD provide special education services?

Eligible students enrolled in The Preuss School UCSD shall receive special education services in accordance with their individualized education programs (I.E.P.). Contact the Admissions office for additional support or questions regarding special education.

When can I visit the school?

The Preuss School UCSD will be having an Open House on November 5, 2011 from 11:30am to 1:30pm. This is a great opportunity to see the campus and meet some of our teachers.

When will the lottery take place?

The lottery will take place in March 2012, on the school campus. The date and time will be posted on the school website. Once the lottery has taken place, all provisionally selected applicants will be asked to re-submit verification of their income in order to comply with the income criteria. Please have your 2011 income tax return available by this time. Admitted students will be notified beginning in April 2012 after income verification has been reviewed.

What if the parents do not speak English?

If the parents speak a language other than English, they may use a translator to complete the application. The ideas should be those of the parents.

How do I turn in the application?

Place the application and additional documents in a large manila envelope. You can mail the application or drop it off at the front desk at the Preuss School. All documents sent via school district mail, must be date stamped by your school clerk Applications will not be accepted by fax.

When are applications due?

Applications for Fall 2012 must be postmarked or received by December 16, 2011. (Note: Applications will not be accepted after 4:00pm on December 16th, **no exceptions**)

What happens after I submit the application?

All applicants will receive a postcard confirming the receipt of their application. It is your responsibility to notify us if your address or phone number has changed. 4. The Writing Sample must be graded (Note: Documents without a grade will NOT be accepted).
5. Please make a copy of your Writing Sample and submit the copy with the rest of your application. (Note: All documents submitted will NOT be returned).
6. You will use the writing sample to answer the questions in SECTION 7.

You must submit the copy of the writing sample with your application.

Applications submitted without the Writing Sample will be considered incomplete and will affect the admissions process for the applicant.
