**CAASPP Testing 2017:** All 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students will be taking the California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) Smarter Balanced English language arts/literacy and mathematics exams May 24<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup>, 31<sup>st</sup>, and June 1<sup>st</sup>. 10<sup>th</sup> grade students will also be taking the new online California Science Test (CAST) Pilot exam on May 24<sup>th</sup>. On assigned testing days, students in all grades should report directly to their Advisory classroom first thing in the morning. A few Advisory classroom locations were adjusted: Agliam will be in E103, Ensberg will be in the LAB, Fulchiron will be in D101, Hawk will be in E102, and Anguiano will in C201 with Ms. Nance. Students, please either don't bring a phone to school that morning or allow enough time to *finish your breakfast, find your posted seating assignment, and check-in your cell phone with your Advisory teacher.* Please try to eat a healthy dinner and get plenty of rest the night before the exam! **(6/1 Ms. Patrick)**
