ATTENTION STUDENTS!

This is an important message for all bus riders:

Beginning this week, we will be collecting the Z pass ID card provided to those students receiving the transportation services. The school bus identification Z pass cards will be returned to the transportation department to be re-programmed for next year. Students must return the Z pass to their advisory teacher or the main office. Riding the school bus without an ID bus pass should not be a problem. Card enforcement on school buses will be suspended during the last week of school. The Z Pass for returning students will be reissue in August. For next school year, SDUSD transportation department will continue using the electronic ID Z Pass Card. END OF YEAR INFORMATION FOR LIBRARY

All library books (not textbooks) are due by Friday, June 15th.

All textbooks are due by the last day of school. You must remove all loose papers from inside the books. Any markings must be erased or whited out. All books are cleaned at the end of each year and damages are marked. If you did not bring any damage to our attention you will be charged at the minimum \$5.00. Lost or missing barcodes are a \$5.00 charge. All this information was provided at the beginning of the year and is in your planner. If you do not need your textbook any longer turn it in early. The lines get really long.

TRANSPORTATION STUDENT ID CARDS (Z PASS)

All students using transportation services are required to have a Z-Pass Bus Card. The Card should be retained by the student for future transportation assignments in the following years (*If eligible only. The card does not guarantee future transportation eligibility).

Please, review the following procedures regarding the use of the transportation Z Pass ID Card:

- Use transportation Student ID Card each day when boarding and exiting the school bus.
- Every student who rides a SDUSD bus must be able to present a Z-Pass Card and scan on and off the bus.
- If the Z-Pass Card is lost, damaged or stolen, students must notify immediately to Mrs. Villanueva and bus driver. The card will be deactivated to prevent unauthorized use, and a replacement card will be ordered. Student may request a temporary Z pass only if transportation did not issue a card.
- Do not request a replacement card if you have forgotten your card. We will not issue a temporary slip. Inform bus driver that you have forgotten the card. A referral may be issue if card is forgotten for three days or more.

- A fee of \$5 will be charged to the students for each replacement card. Students can order a replacement card in the Preuss School Transportation office with Mrs. Villanueva. A temporary pass will be issued to the student to ride the school bus.
- Students may ride the bus in the interim and should be prepared to provide their Preuss Student ID or a temporary pass for manual entry. Mrs. Villanueva will issue to the student a temporary pass to use during the replacement process.
- Students **MUST NOT** share their Z-Pass Card. Students sharing their Z- Pass may be subjected to disciplinary action. (Villanueva) **Patricia Villanueva** Attendance and Transportation Coordinator.
