The 2nd Annual Preuss Town Hall Series begins this week. High school students will have the opportunity to meet candidates running for local elected offices beginning on Thursday, September 21st, from 4-5:15pm, in E202.

This week's candidate is Christian Ramirez, Democratic candidate for San Diego City Council, District 8

San Diego City Council has the power to affect your life in a variety of ways including the conditions of your streets, parks, libraries, as well as treatment of homeless people and others who require city services.

The 8th district includes Barrio Logan, Logan Heights, Grant Hill, Stockton, Shelltown, and the border neighborhoods of Palm City, Nestor, Otay Mesa, and San Ysidro.

If you live in any of these neighborhoods, you have an opportunity to ask Mr. Ramirez questions about how we would improve life in your neighborhoods if he is elected to represent you. If you don't live in District 8 and are simply interested in the political process, you are also welcome to attend.
