CHANGES ON THE SCHOOL BUS SCHEDULE

In an effort to get the buses on time, transportation adjusted the school bus schedule. Starting September 11, the buses will operate on a different itinerary. Be aware that the transportation changes will have an impact on the morning pick up for students assigned to the routes A, B, C, D, E, and H. In addition, students from the bus O at Garfield stop were moved back to bus H.

Remember, all students must arrive at the bus stop 10 minutes prior to the designated pick-up time. UC/CSU Eligibility Policy:

The mission of The Preuss School is to prepare students for acceptance to a 4-year university. In order for seniors to take advantage of the school's mission, students from grades 8-11 need to be on track to be UC/CSU College eligible.

-In order to be on track towards college eligibility, students in grades 8-11 need to pass their Math, English, Science, and History classes with a C- or better.

-Students earning lower than a C- need to take advantage of Preuss' many academic supports to improve their academic performance.

-Students earning lower than a C- who DO NOT take advantage of Preuss' supports will have the opportunity to get back on track towards college eligibility by repeating an entire grade.
