On this day, the Treaty of Paris of 1898 was signed, ending the Spanish-American War. Following the capsizing of the USS Maine, killing 260 Americans, President William McKinley placed his suspicions on Spain and eventually declared war. The battle was clearly one-sided favoring the superior American forces, so the war ended in only four months. As a result, Spain relinquished almost all of their overseas territories to the U.S., including Puerto Rico, Guam, the Philippines, and Cuba. (1898) (Greco 12/10)
