Pan Am Flight 103, intended to fly from London to New York, explodes mid-air over Scotland, killing all 259 on board and 11 residents on the ground. The cause was found to be a bomb hidden inside a cassette player that was detonated in the cargo deck. After almost three years of investigation, the U.S. and Britain indicted Libyan intelligence agents Abdel al-Megrahi and Lamem Fhimah for murder. In 2003, Libya accepted responsibility for the explosion by paying each victim's family \$8 million. (1988) (Greco 12/21)
