On this day, President Franklin D. Roosevelt signs the Executive Order 9066, ten weeks after the bombing of Pearl Harbor, authorizing the removal of any or all people from military areas "as deemed necessary or desirable." As a result, only after four months, over 110,000 Japanese-Americans were relocated into remote internment camps scattered across the country, enduring harsh conditions and poor treatment from guards.
