On this day, Nevada becomes the first state in U.S. history to hold an execution by lethal gas. The executed man was Tong Lee, a Chinese gang member who was convicted for the murder of a rival member. Lethal gas was proposed as a more humane method of the death sentence in which they produce hydrocyanic gas that destroys a human's ability to process blood hemoglobin, and kills them within seconds.
