Rho Kappa Social Studies Honor Society presents This Day in History:

On this day, Elizabeth Blackwell becomes the first female to receive an M.D. in U.S. history. Born in England, Blackwell graduated at the top of her class at Hobart College in New York, and became officially recognized as a physician. She then founded the New York Infirmary for Women and Children that included a women's college for the training of nurses and doctors, a first of its kind. (1849)(Greco 1/23)

Preuss Model United Nations announcement to develop "Good Global Citizens:

The United Nation's Chief Economist, Elliott Harris, warns that even though the global economy is projected to grow at a fixed rate of 3% in 2019 like last year, this growth is uneven across the world and could be jeopardized by recent economic developments. Accelerating trade tensions are impacting global trade and employment, and increasing national debt is incapacitating many countries' ability to provide basic services. Harris asserts that such pressures could be averted or minimized if there was greater international cooperation. (Greco 1/22)
