On this day, the first Winter Olympics were held at Chamonix in the French Alps, largely inspired by the Nordic Games. Known as the "International Winter Sports Week" at the time, the event was huge success and was designated to happen every four years, as with the Summer Olympics. The event was dominated by the Scandinavians, with Norway winning 17 medals throughout the six total sports offered. (1924) (Greco 1/25)
