On this day, U.S Senator Henry Clay introduced the Compromise of 1850 to Congress. This compromise consisted of five bills, which included California's admittance as a free state, Texas's surrender of New Mexico, the prohibition of slave trading in Washington D.C., the disregard of the Wilmot Proviso, and the enactment of the Fugitive Slave Law, which required slaves from the North to be returned to their owners.
