**TRANSPORTATION STUDENT ID CARD PROCEDURES**

Transportation Student ID Z Pass Cards have been issued to all Preuss students receiving transportation services and they will continue to use their existing ID card while attending school. For students that were not issued a card or need a replacement please contact Mrs. Villanueva. New and replacement cards will be generated weekly throughout the school year. This ID card will only be used for transportation services; your student will continue to use their current student ID for all school activities.

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT TRANSPORTATION STUDENT ID CARDS**

- Students must use Transportation Student ID Card each day when boarding and exiting the school bus.
- The Z pass card may be scanned across or touched to the Card Reader on dash.
- The Card Reader may read your Transportation Student ID Card even under clothing or when stored in a backpack. However, if the Reader is unable to do so, please be prepared to retrieve the card so you may board the bus.
- Notify the school front office immediately if Card is lost or stolen.
- The Card should be retained by the student for future transportation assignments in the following years. (\*If eligible only. The card does not guarantee future eligibility)

We encourage students to take care of their Transportation Student ID Card as they will function for many years and should not need to be replaced. **(5/31 Mrs. Villanueva)**
