10/13/17	Ramon 'Chunky' Sanchez	Ramon 'Chunky' Sanchez, was born to Mexican immigrant parents in the California desert town of Blythe, Both of his parents were farm laborers, and he himself worked in the fields, so Sánchez learned early on in life about the struggles in the farm labor movement. As he listened and learned, he began to compose his own music with a bicultural influence and often sociopolitical messages and he was frequently asked to play by César Chávez at rallies and marches for the United Farm Workers Union. He later became the lead vocalist for the Mexican-Chicano folklore group Los Alacranes (The Scorpions), which he co-founded along with his brother Ricardo. He expressed the concerns and causes of the community with the rich Chicano musical traditions. One of his best-known pieces, "Chicano Park Samba," narrated the struggle for and successful creation of Chicano Park in San Diego and became an anthem for that community and Chicano communities throughout Aztlan. Sanchez passed away last year, at the age of 67. His legacy of activism will continue to live on in his music, his message, and those that were fortunate enough to know him.
