On this day, the US Supreme Court made their decision in the *Sanford v. Dred Scott* case. Dred Scott was a slave who sued for his freedom because he lived in Wisconsin, a free state, with his master until his master died. However, the Court ruled against this, stating that Scott was not considered a citizen under the Constitution, and therefore could not sue in court. This case contradicted the Missouri Compromise, highlighted the government's stance on slavery, and further inflamed the division between the North and South that would eventually lead to the Civil War.
