Preuss Model United Nations announcement to develop "Good Global Citizens": Devastation in Indonesia

The UN High Commissioner for Refugees stated the the devastation caused by the recent Sulawesi Indonesian 7.5 magnitude earthquake and tsunami was "beyond imaginable". With over 2000 people dead, more than 80,000 people displaced, and many unaccounted for, a massive aid operation is underway. Emergency equipment such as tents, sleeping mats, and solar lamps, are being delivered to Indonesian authorities in order to provide relief for those affected by the disaster, which had decimated communities and entire villages.
