### This Day in History:

On this day in 1951, the Twenty-second Amendment to the US Constitution, which limits a president to two terms, is ratified by the states. The president had not been subject to term limits before, although George Washington had set a precedent of serving only two terms. This was broken by President Franklin D. Roosevelt, who was elected to four terms, which reignited the debate about how long a president should serve. After Roosevelt's death early in his final term in 1945, many members of Congress made it a priority to create a constitutional amendment limiting how long a person could serve as president.
