

Arrests for Organizing Bus Boycott in Montgomery, Alabama On February 20, 1956, Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., Rosa Parks, and more civil rights activists had warrants issued out for their arrests. They were being charged for organizing the Montgomery Bus Boycott which didn't have a "just cause". Dr. King was the only one prosecuted and was convicted, fined, and given a suspended jail sentence of one year despite evidence of a peaceful boycott.
