On the year 1894, the House of Congress would repeal the Enforcement Act. These acts provided protection by the government after the Civil for the rights of black people to vote, hold office, serve on juries, and receive equal protection by law. The repeal of this Act would propel many southern states to revert back to disenfranchising African American voters.
