

a loaner polo or pants.




ATTENTION LATE STUDENTS?

Students that arrive habitually tardy will now be assigned lunch duty with our amazing custodial team!


Once you accumulate 5 tardies, you will be given a referral and assigned lunch duty. This may include trash pickup, lunch monitoring, or other tasks as needed.
