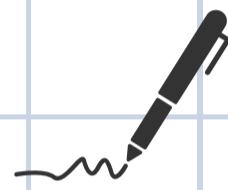
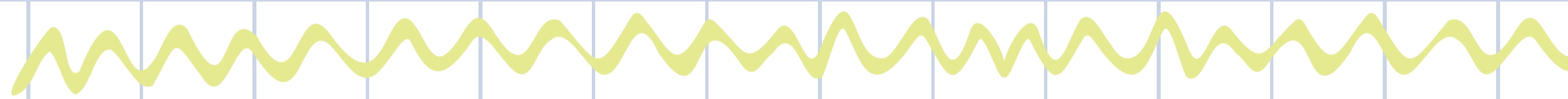

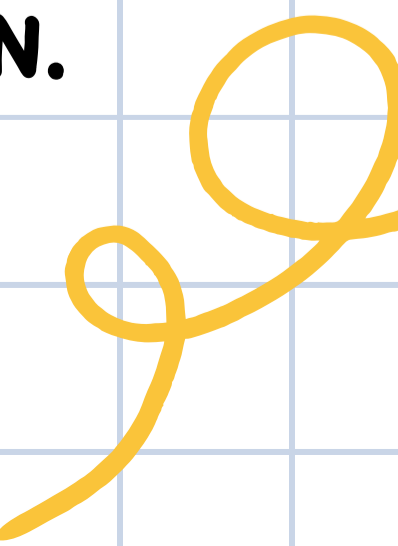

### **If you encounter ICE on the street**

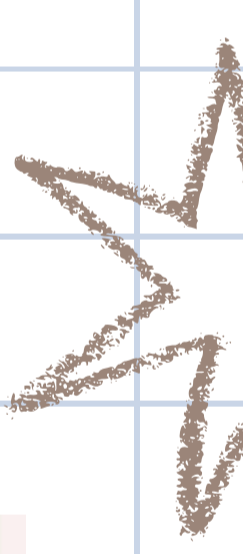
- NOT required to stop and talk with them, answer questions, or show documents
- Say " I know I have the Right to Remain Silent"
- Am I under arrest or am I free to go?

### **If ICE comes to your home:**

- Don't open the door. Ask them, with the door closed, "Do you have a warrant?"
- Have them slide the warrant under the door. The warrant must be signed by a judge and have the correct name and address.
  - If they do enter, you have the right to remain silent and the right to speak to a lawyer.
  - Do not sign any document.

### EXPLANATION OF WARRANT NEEDED

- A phrase to practice is: "I'm not sure what this is about, but I know that I have the right to remain silent"
- Calmly and respectfully ask "Am I under arrest or am I free to go?"
- Kindness goes a long way with ICE and police
- Avoid taking risks and being in the wrong place at the wrong time
- Remain respectful and calm

# It's Testing Week!

## FIVE TIPS FOR CALMER TEST-TAKING



### 1. TALK YOURSELF UP!

Tell yourself things like:

- I can do this!
- I know the material.
- I am ready.
- I have practiced this.
- I am capable.
- I am prepared.



### 2. VISUALIZE.

Close your eyes and picture yourself doing well on the test. This will boost your confidence!



### 3. RELAX YOUR MUSCLES.

Begin at your toes. Tighten and clench them for three seconds, and then release. Work your way through all the muscles in your body until you've tensed and relaxed them all.



### 4. TAKE DEEP BREATHS.

This is a great anxiety reliever. Sit up straight and put your hands on the top of your head. Breathe in a slow, deep breath through your nose for five full seconds. Hold that breath in for five seconds. Then breathe out for seven seconds. Repeat until you feel better.



### 5. GET SILLY!

There are many playful ways to relax before a test.

- **Think of something funny!**  
Like a cat grading the test!
- **Get out all the wiggles.**  
Dance, shake, and move around!
- **Raise your hands up above your head!**  
It will help you to feel victorious.
- **Force a smile or laugh.**  
This will help you feel better.

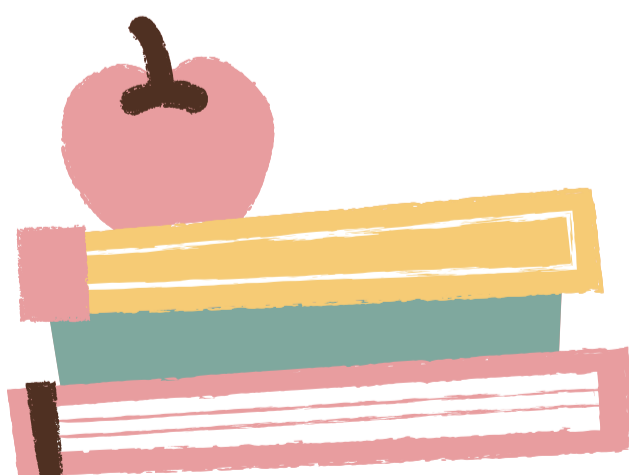

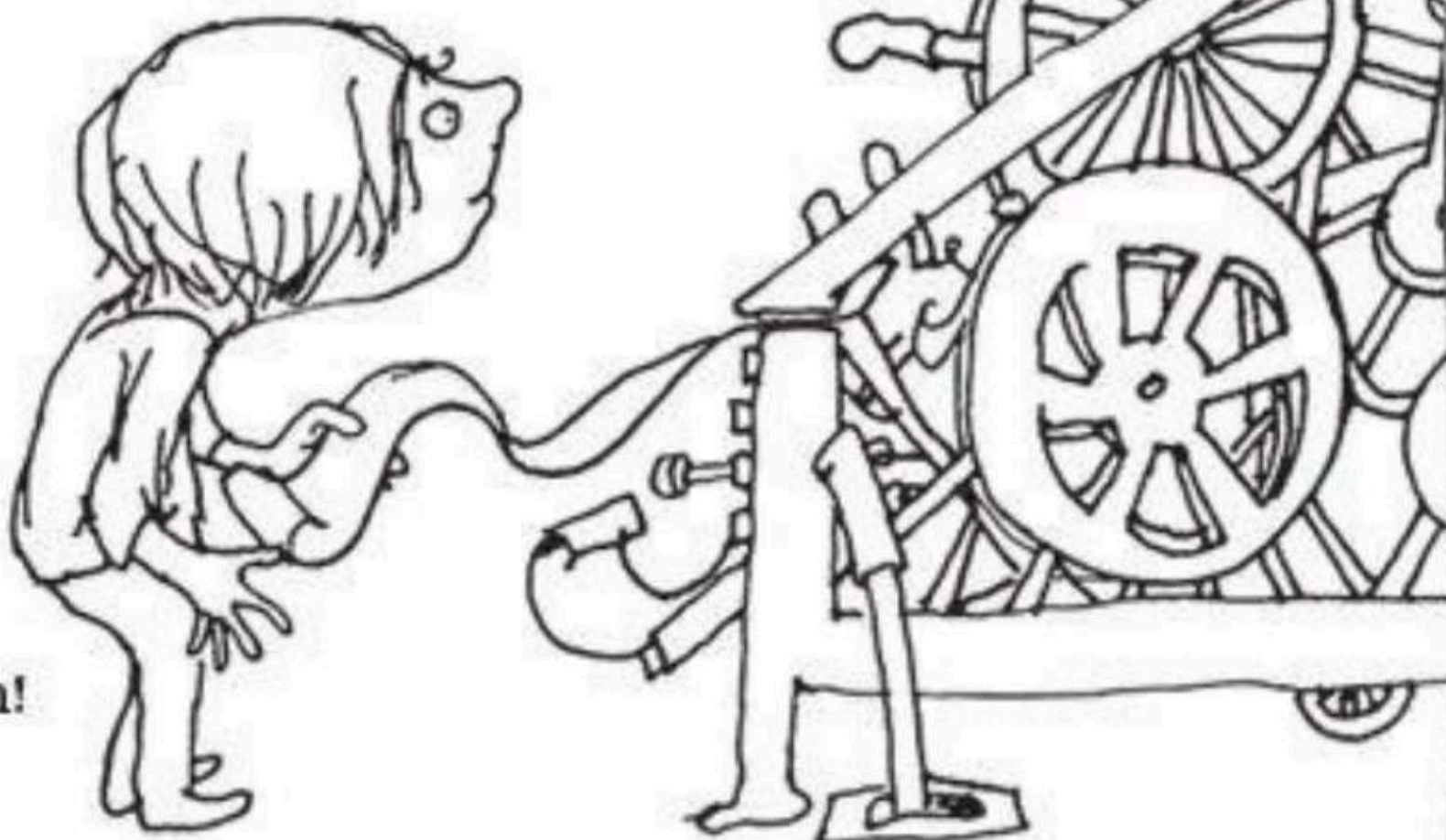
## *“Homework Machine”*

# Musical Fact of the Week

## Tri-M Musical Fact of the Week

Around the year 1700, Italian inventor Bartolomeo Cristofori introduced the pianoforte in Florence, replacing the harpsichord's plucking mechanism with a hammer system that struck the strings.

This important change allowed musicians to control volume, playing both soft (piano) and loud (forte) sounds for the first time, something that wasn't possible before. Known early on as the fortepiano, this instrument gave performers more expression and creativity in their music. Over time, it was improved and developed into the modern piano we use today, becoming one of the most important and widely used instruments in the world.
