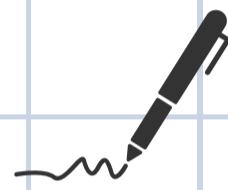
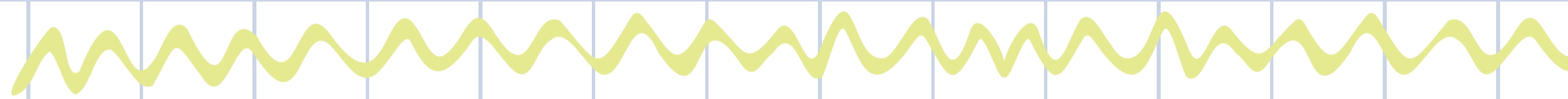

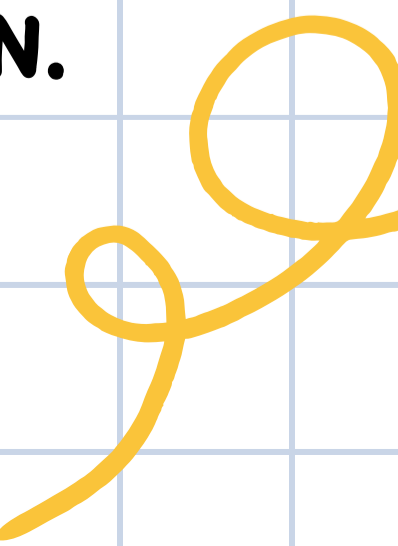

Pick up a copy of your **Wallet Card** from the front office (both English and Spanish available; also available for printing on the website).

If you encounter ICE on the street

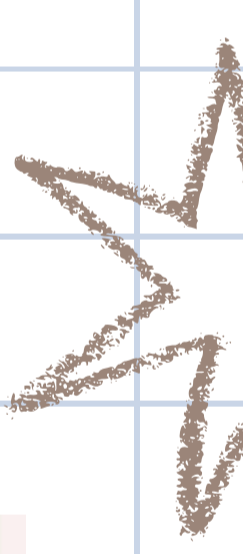
- NOT required to stop and talk with them, answer questions, or show documents
- Say " I know I have the Right to Remain Silent"
- Am I under arrest or am I free to go?

If ICE comes to your home:

- Don't open the door. Ask them, with the door closed, "Do you have a warrant?"
- Have them slide the warrant under the door. The warrant must be signed by a judge and have the correct name and address.
 - If they do enter, you have the right to remain silent and the right to speak to a lawyer.
 - Do not sign any document.

EXPLANATION OF WARRANT NEEDED

- A phrase to practice is: "I'm not sure what this is about, but I know that I have the right to remain silent"
- Calmly and respectfully ask "Am I under arrest or am I free to go?"
- Kindness goes a long way with ICE and police
- Avoid taking risks and being in the wrong place at the wrong time
- Remain respectful and calm

Arriving at class on time

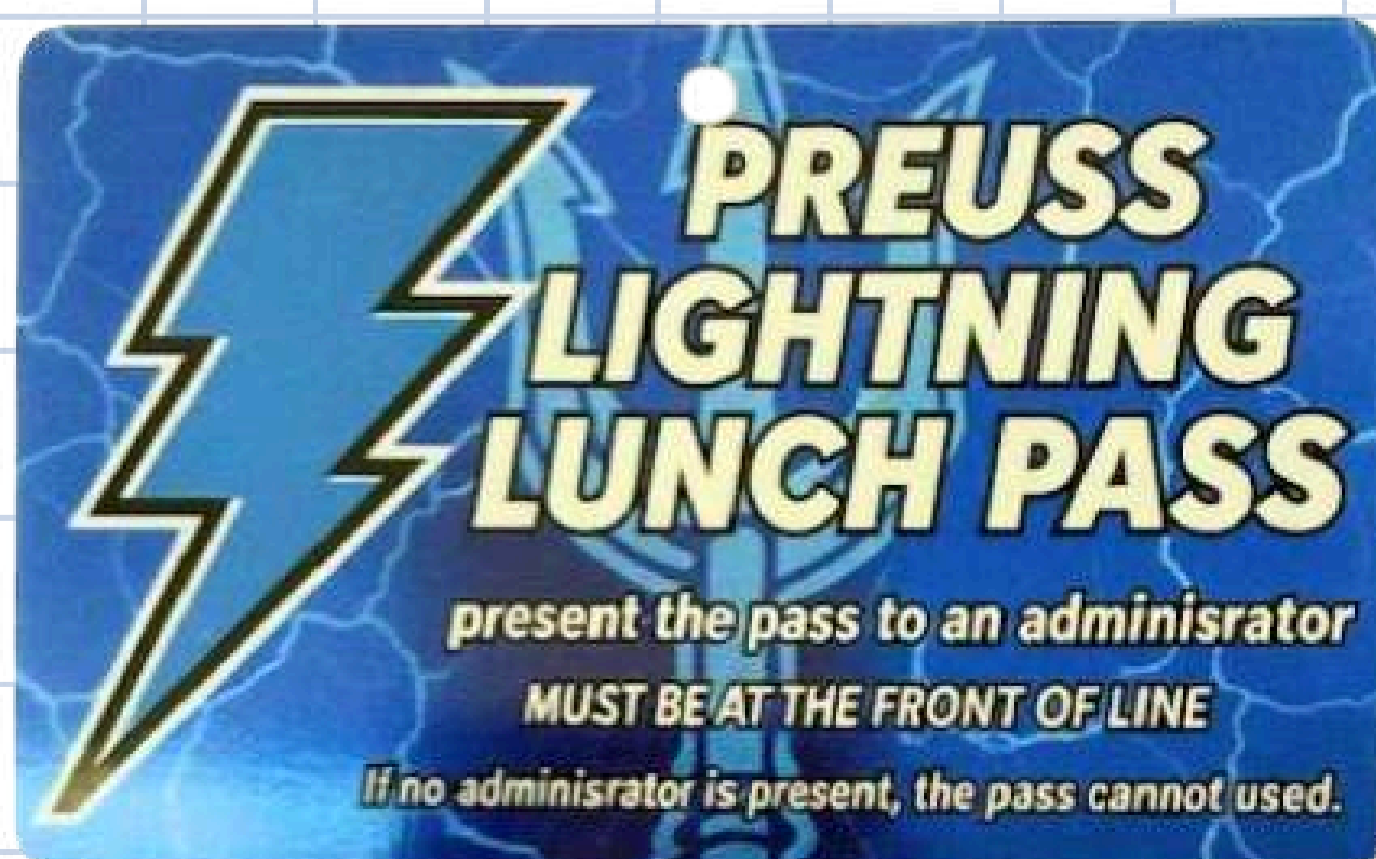
Picking up trash during lunch

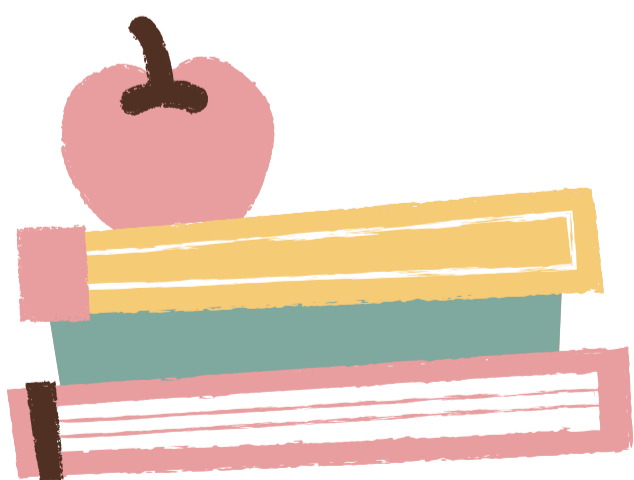

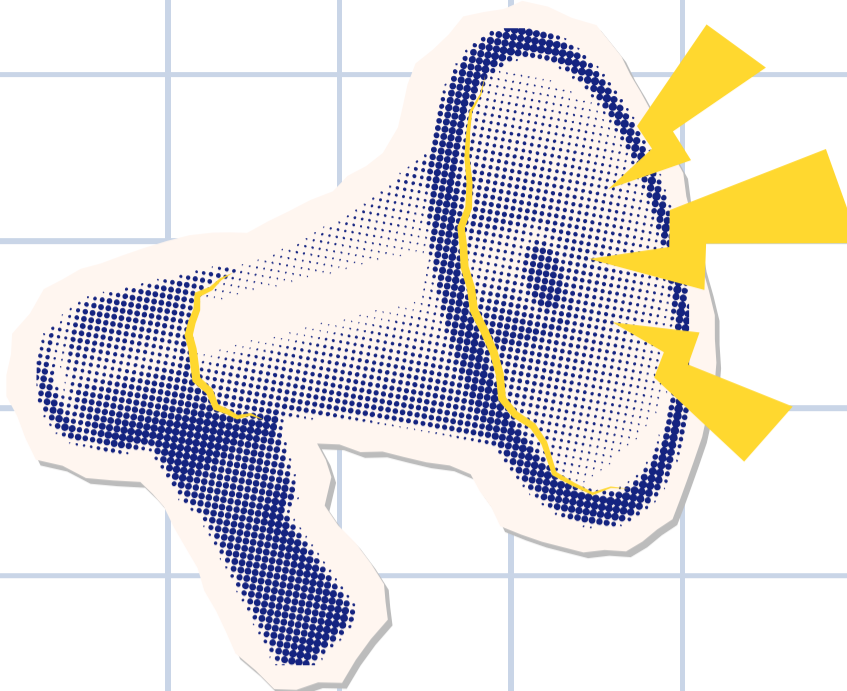

 According to ancient tradition and legend, on this day the city of Troy fell to the Greek invaders through a wooden, giant horse most commonly known as the Trojan Horse!



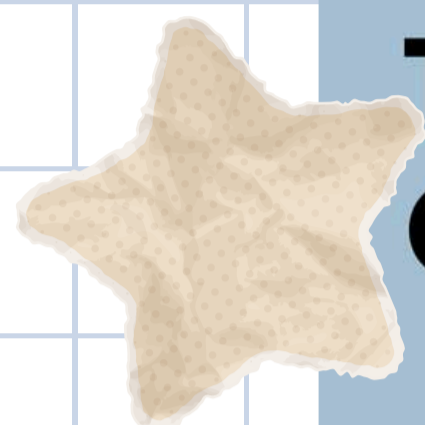

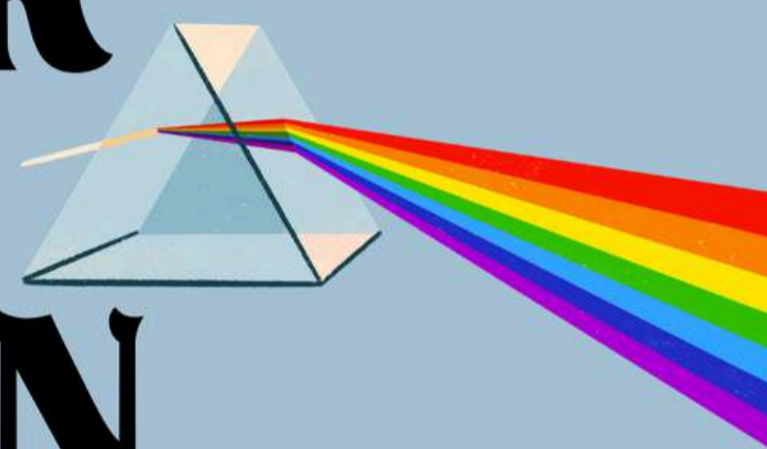

THE DARK SIDE OF THE MOON BY PINK FLOYD PIONEERED THE IDEA OF A FULLY CONTINUOUS ALBUM, WITH TRACKS LIKE "SPEAK TO ME" FLOWING DIRECTLY INTO "BREATHE" AND RECURRING MUSICAL MOTIFS TYING THE WHOLE RECORD TOGETHER.

IT INTRODUCED SPECIFIC STUDIO INNOVATIONS (SUCH AS TAPE LOOPS OF CLOCKS IN "TIME," SYNTHESIZED TEXTURES, AND MULTI-TRACK VOCAL LAYERING ENGINEERED BY ALAN PARSONS) THAT BECAME STANDARD IN MODERN PRODUCTION.

THE ALBUM'S EXPLORATION OF UNIVERSAL THEMES LIKE TIME, MENTAL HEALTH, AND GREED GAVE ROCK MUSIC A DEEPER EMOTIONAL WEIGHT.

THE ALBUM HAD AN UNPRECEDENTED RUN OF OVER 900 WEEKS ON THE BILLBOARD 200.

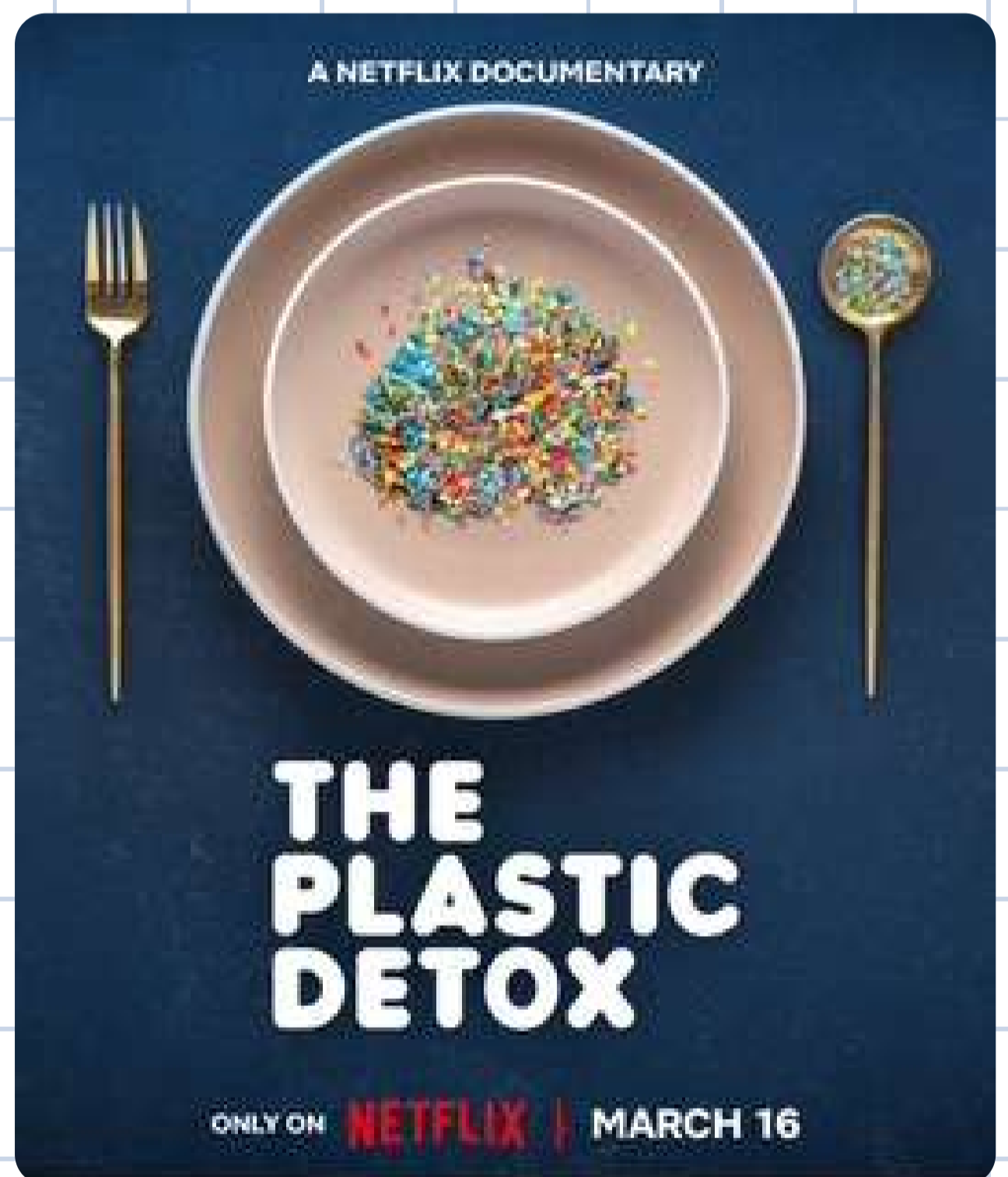

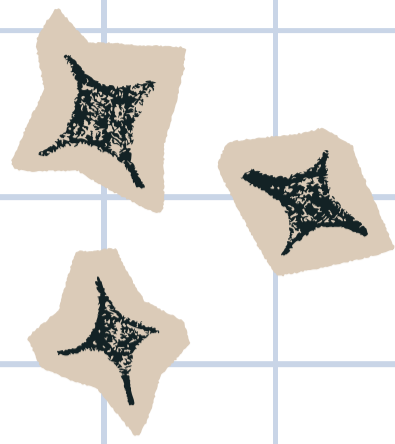

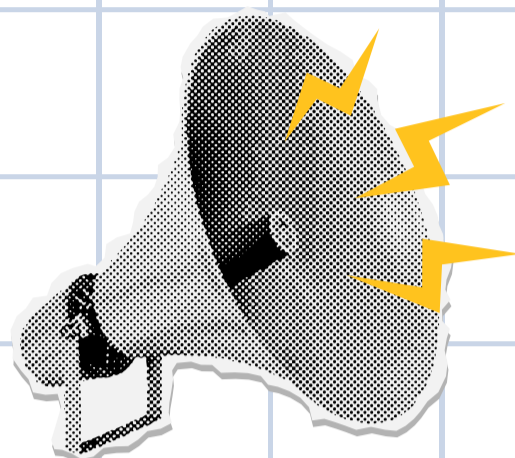
