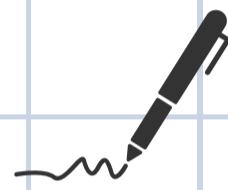
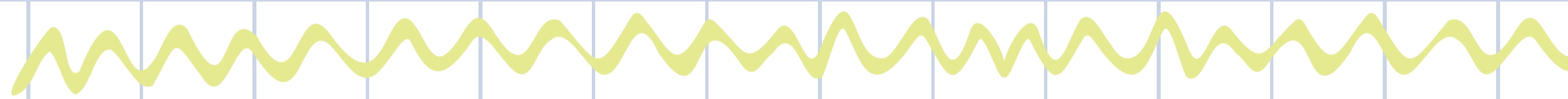

Pick up a copy of your **Wallet Card** from the front office (both English and Spanish available; also available for printing on the website).

If you encounter ICE on the street

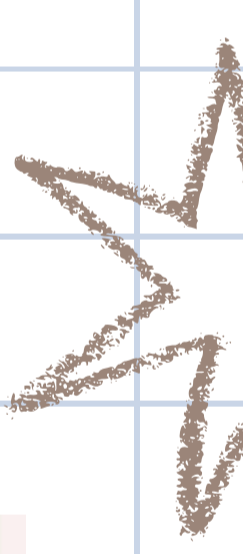
- NOT required to stop and talk with them, answer questions, or show documents
- Say " I know I have the Right to Remain Silent"
- Am I under arrest or am I free to go?

If ICE comes to your home:

- Don't open the door. Ask them, with the door closed, "Do you have a warrant?"
- Have them slide the warrant under the door. The warrant must be signed by a judge and have the correct name and address.
 - If they do enter, you have the right to remain silent and the right to speak to a lawyer.
 - Do not sign any document.

EXPLANATION OF WARRANT NEEDED

- A phrase to practice is: "I'm not sure what this is about, but I know that I have the right to remain silent"
- Calmly and respectfully ask "Am I under arrest or am I free to go?"
- Kindness goes a long way with ICE and police
- Avoid taking risks and being in the wrong place at the wrong time
- Remain respectful and calm

Showing random acts of kindness or leadership

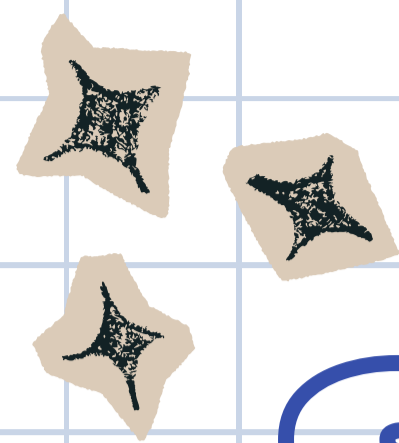
Once you earn a Lightning Lunch Pass, it's yours to keep — **there is no expiration date.** You may redeem it on any day you choose.

(VP Agliam, VP Brown, or Dr. Steitz) must be available to escort you to the **front of the lunch line.**

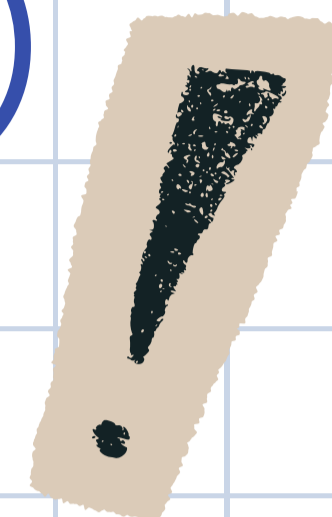

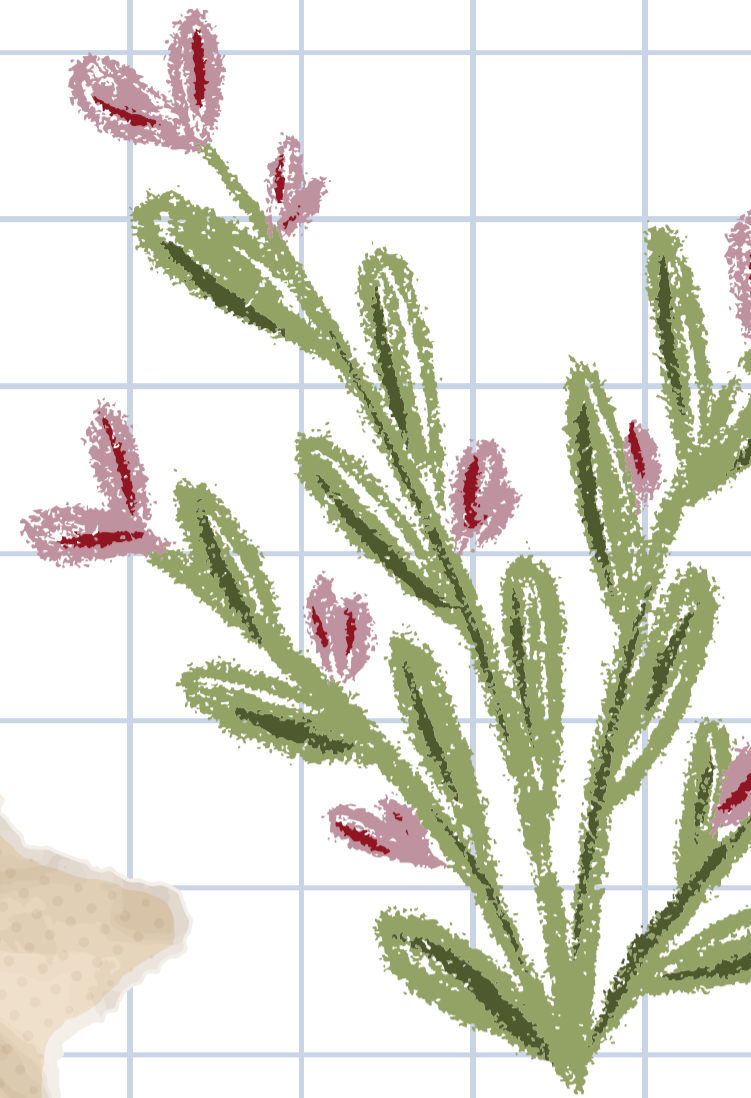

William "Smokey" Robinson Jr. (Feb. 19, 1940) is a famous singer and songwriter, best known as the frontman of the Motown group, the Miracles. With hits like "Ooo Baby Baby" and "Cruisin," he helped shape modern R&B and soul music while influencing many artists.



Feb. 19th, 1942

On this day, the Tuskegee Airmen were the first African Americans to serve as U.S. military pilots and were officially on active duty. This was a major step for African Americans in the U.S. Army Air Corps during WWII.



Feb. 19th, 1864

During the Civil War, the 24th Amendment was ratified, abolishing the poll tax. This was an important step toward ensuring voting rights for African Americans!

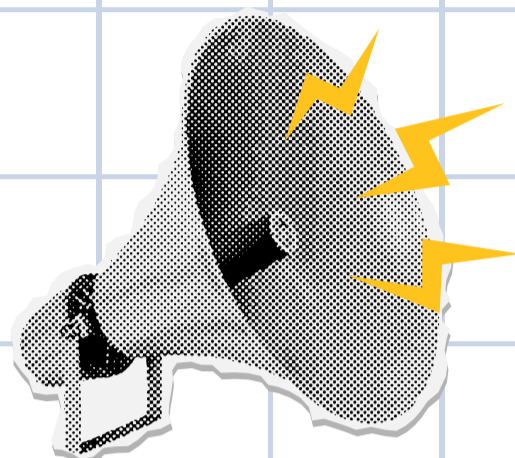
WHAT IS RED CROSS?
