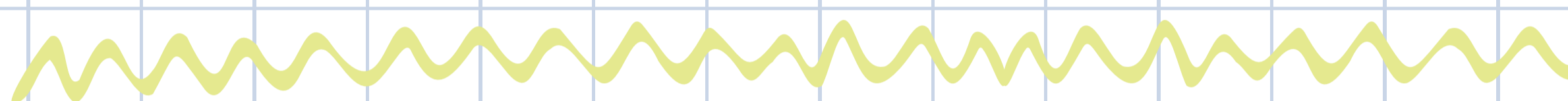

Pick up a copy of your **Wallet Card** from the front office (both English and Spanish available; also available for printing on the website).

If you encounter ICE on the street

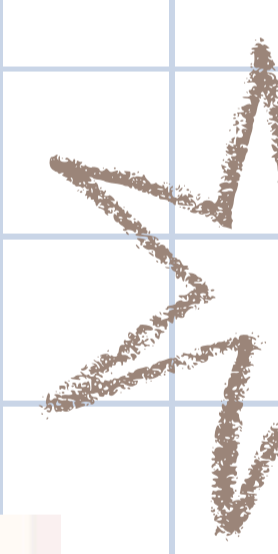
- NOT required to stop and talk with them, answer questions, or show documents
- Say " I know I have the Right to Remain Silent"
- Am I under arrest or am I free to go?

If ICE comes to your home:

- Don't open the door. Ask them, with the door closed, "Do you have a warrant?"
- Have them slide the warrant under the door. The warrant must be signed by a judge and have the correct name and address.
 - If they do enter, you have the right to remain silent and the right to speak to a lawyer.
 - Do not sign any document.

EXPLANATION OF WARRANT NEEDED

- A phrase to practice is: "I'm not sure what this is about, but I know that I have the right to remain silent"
- Calmly and respectfully ask "Am I under arrest or am I free to go?"
- Kindness goes a long way with ICE and police
- Avoid taking risks and being in the wrong place at the wrong time
- Remain respectful and calm

Arriving at class on time

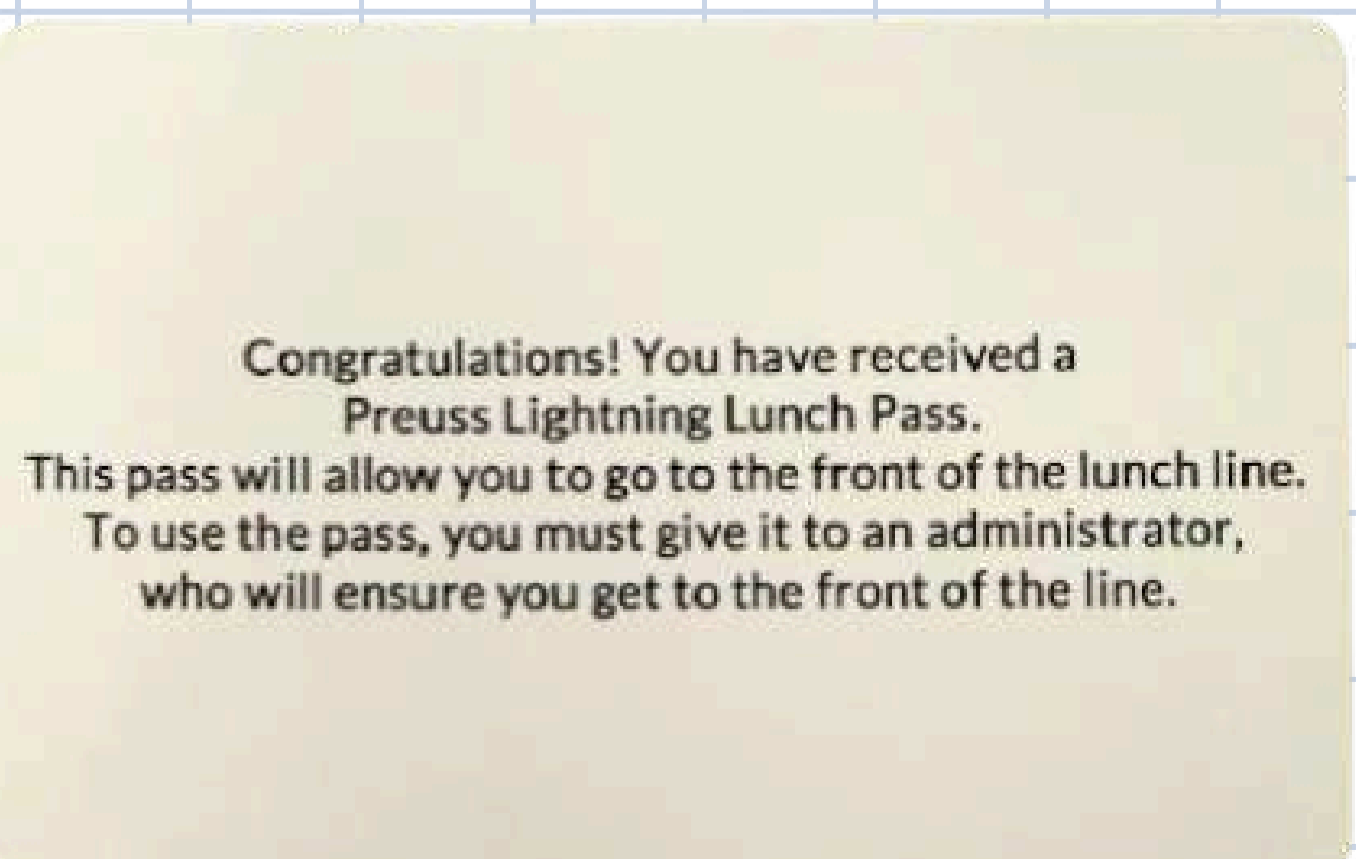
Picking up trash during lunch

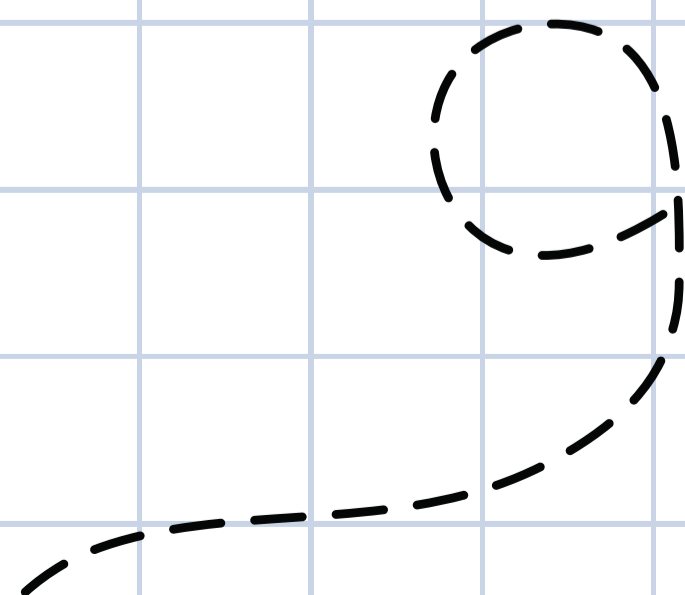

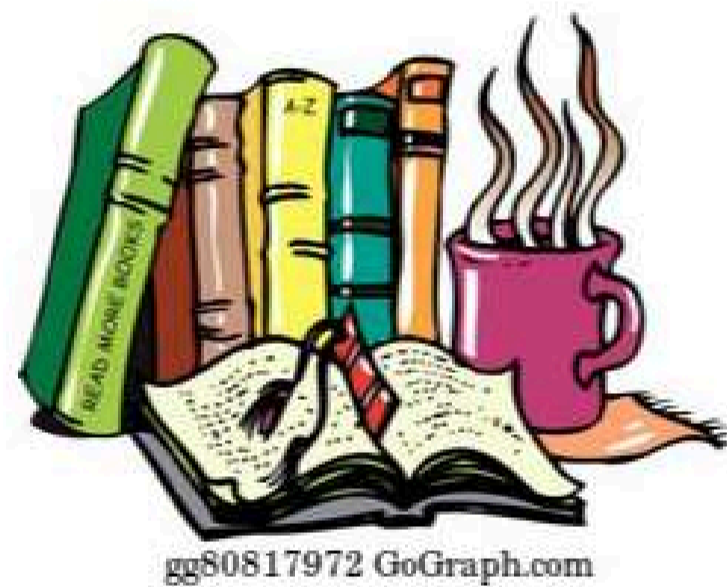

To promote literacy and creativity, The Preuss School Library is hosting its Annual **Bookmark Contest** beginning **Friday, January 16th** and ending **Tuesday, February 17th** with the **announcements of winners**, for all interested Preuss students! FROM UGARIT (MODERN SYRIA), FOUND ON CLAY TABLETS WITH INSTRUCTIONS FOR A NINE-STRINGED LYRE DEDICATED TO THE GODDESS NIKKAL, OFFERING A WINDOW INTO ANCIENT MUSIC, THOUGH INTERPRETATIONS OF ITS MELODY VARY AMONG SCHOLARS.

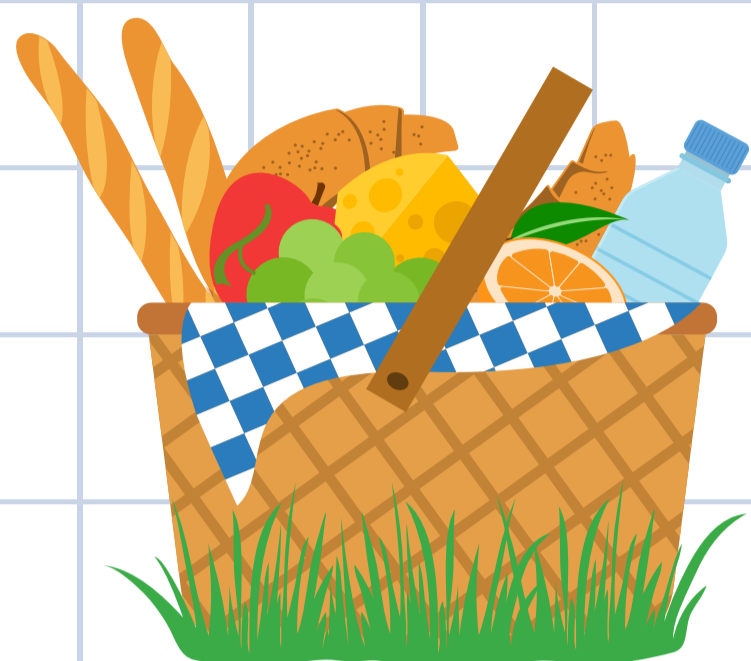
The Women's March was held in Washington, D.C. a day after President Donald Trump's inauguration in support of gender equality, civil rights, and other reforms. Trump had gained attention for his political views and controversial remarks, mostly about women. "Sister marches" arose nationwide and in other countries like France, Brazil, Australia, Kenya, and more! Around 5.3 million supporters had joined the movement, making it the largest single-day demonstration in U.S. history until the "No Kings" protests (June 14, 2025).



Jan. 22nd, 1973

In a decision of 7-2, The Supreme Court case Roe v. Wade established the woman's constitutional right to an abortion under the right to privacy in the 14th Amendment. For 50 years, abortion was protected by the federal government, however, it was overturned in 2022 by Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization. Abortion continues to be a topic of national discussion today.

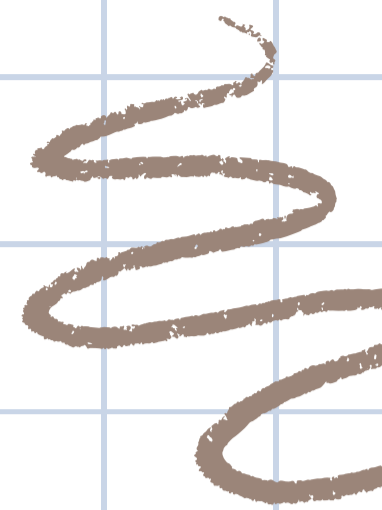

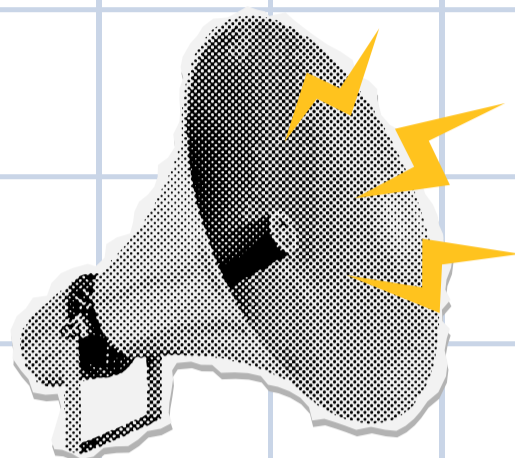
