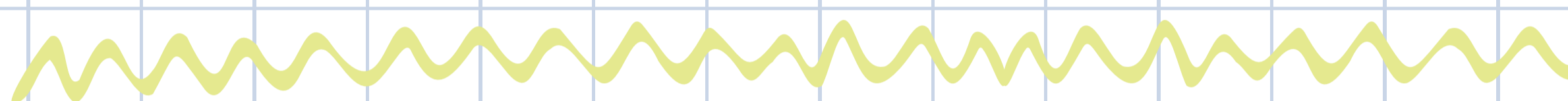

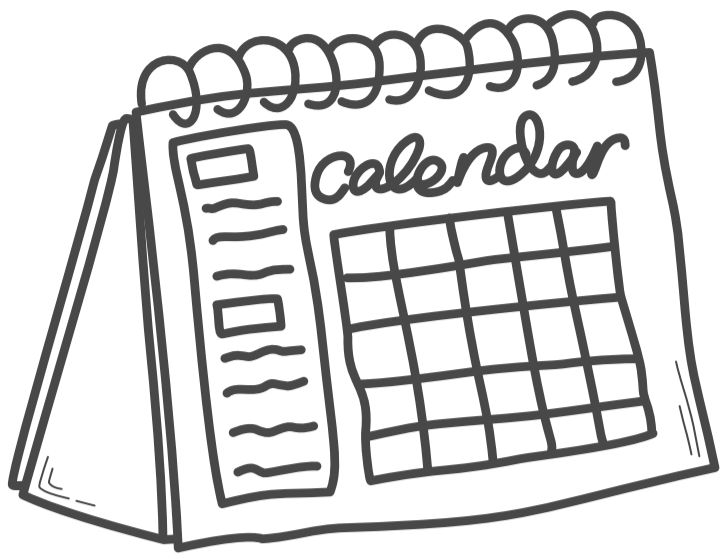

Pick up a copy of your **Wallet Card** from the front office (both English and Spanish available; also available for printing on the website).

If you encounter ICE on the street

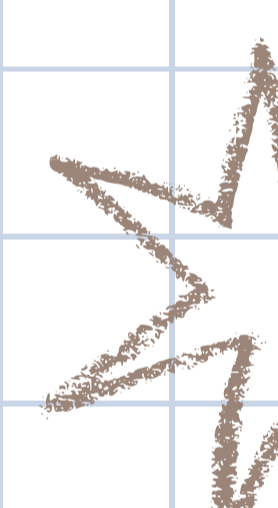
- NOT required to stop and talk with them, answer questions, or show documents
- Say " I know I have the Right to Remain Silent"
- Am I under arrest or am I free to go?

If ICE comes to your home:

- Don't open the door. Ask them, with the door closed, "Do you have a warrant?"
- Have them slide the warrant under the door. The warrant must be signed by a judge and have the correct name and address.
 - If they do enter, you have the right to remain silent and the right to speak to a lawyer.
 - Do not sign any document.

EXPLANATION OF WARRANT NEEDED

- A phrase to practice is: "I'm not sure what this is about, but I know that I have the right to remain silent"
- Calmly and respectfully ask "Am I under arrest or am I free to go?"
- Kindness goes a long way with ICE and police
- Avoid taking risks and being in the wrong place at the wrong time
- Remain respectful and calm

Arriving at class on time

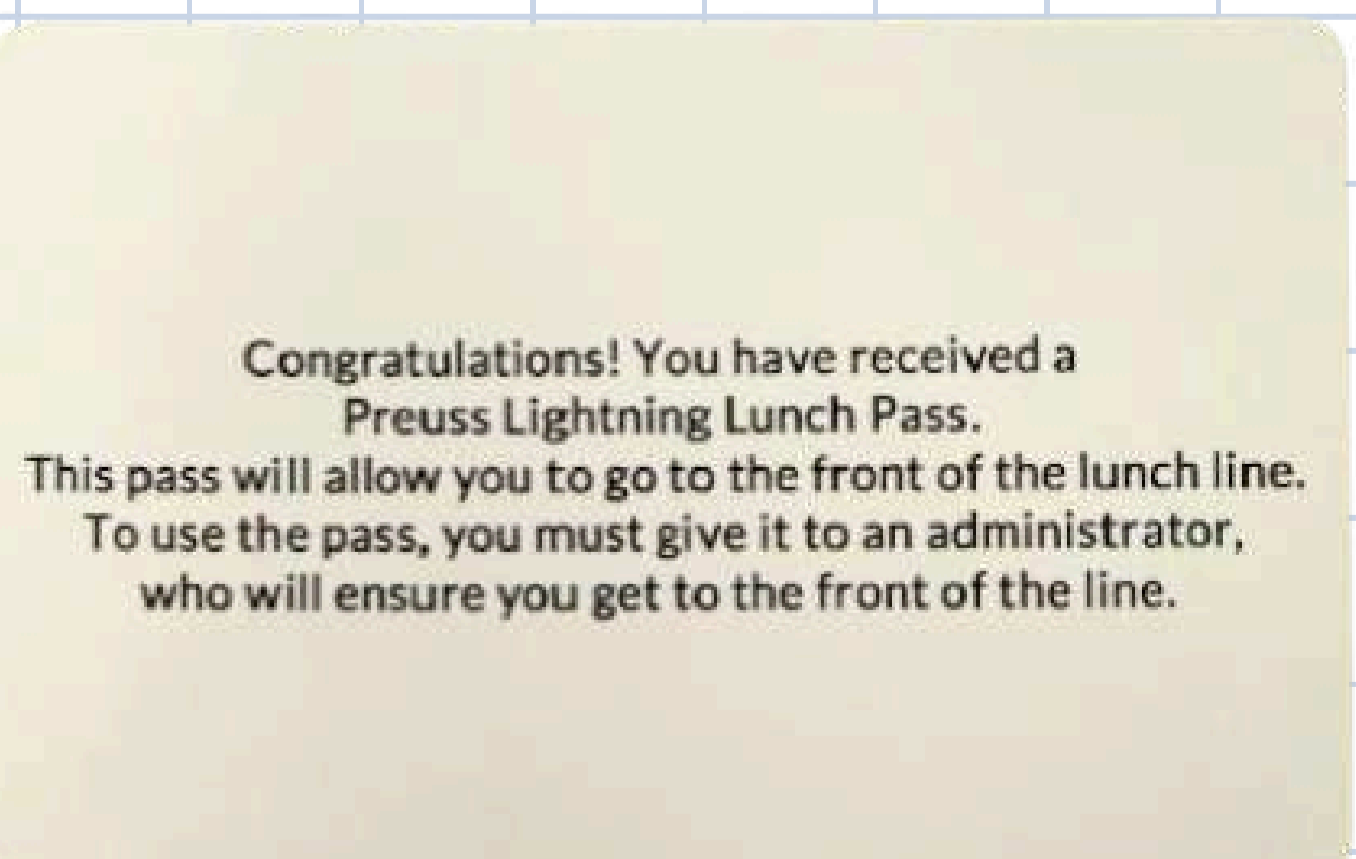
Picking up trash during lunch

BIRTHDAY ANNOUNCEMENTS!
Opera Conductor Sarah Caldwell (March 6, 1924) helped break gender barriers within the male-dominated opera field and became the first woman to conduct at the Metropolitan Opera in 1976. Her remarkable skills would help earn her the National Medal of Arts in 1997.



March 6th, 1971
The Women's Liberation Movement had their first national March in which ~5,000 women and supporters marched to demand for equal pay and education, as well as 24 hour nurseries. Unlike their previous campaigning, this one was visible to the public and purposeful; it helped bring together different factions within the movement to unify for one cause. Through their valiant efforts, the movement was able to ultimately transform society by challenging gender discrimination and pushing for equality.

March 6th, 1993
First Lady Eleanor Roosevelt holds the first ever women-only press conference in the White House. This move on her part was to ensure that women were also included in the news during a time when it seemed that men were the only ones that could participate. She would go on to continue this tradition for the next 12 years of President Roosevelt's terms, ensuring that women journalists remained employed and had access to high-level information.

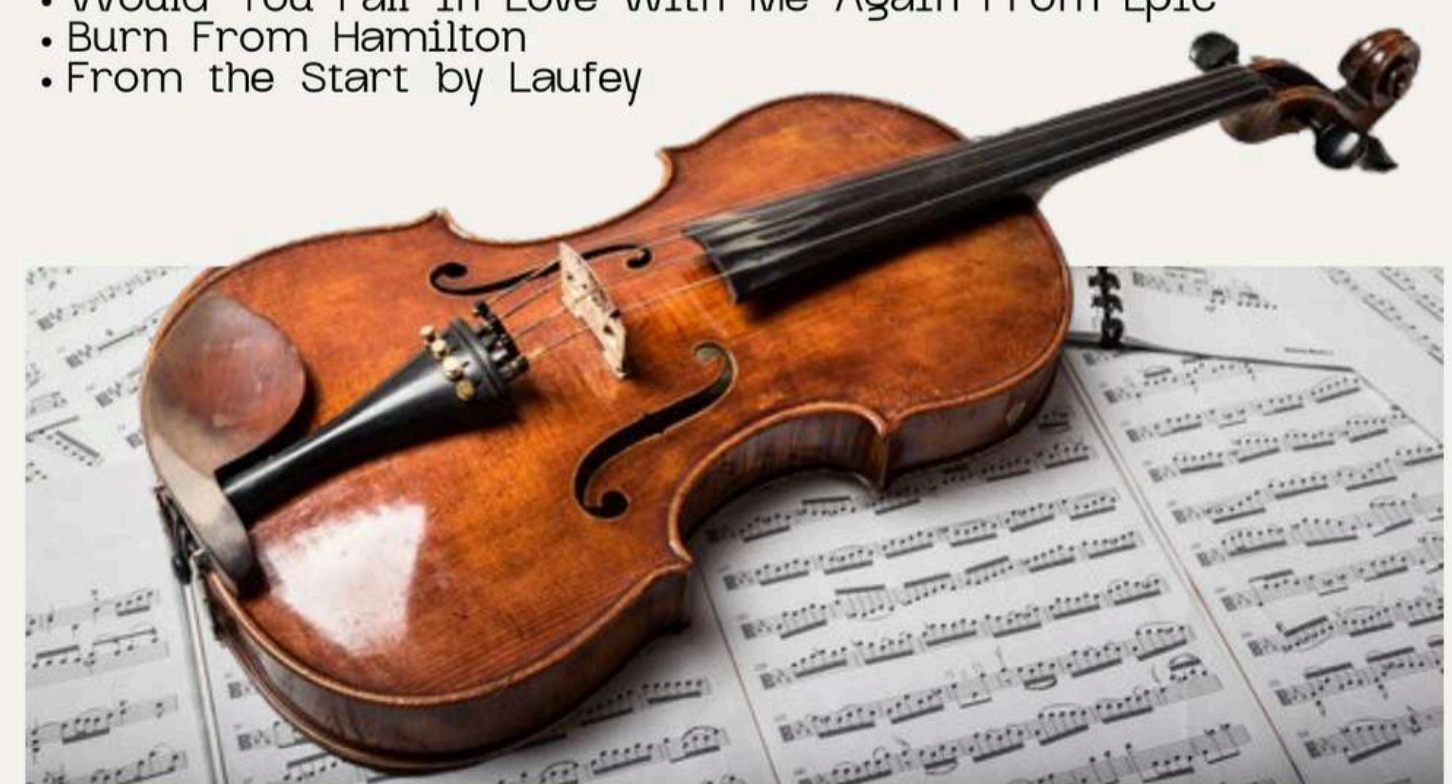
Musical Fact of the Week

The viola is one of the least known string instruments that are used in an orchestra. This instrument was created around the early 16th century in Italy by Andrea Amati and Gaspare de Salo of the Brescia region. Its name as well as all stringed instrument were derived from the saying, "viola de braccio" and "viola de gambia" which means "viola played in the arm." The viola is an alto instrument that was created to fill harmonies between the cello and violin. Though it might not stand out while in an orchestra, it plays a major part in pulling in music together and having that harmonic bridge feeling.

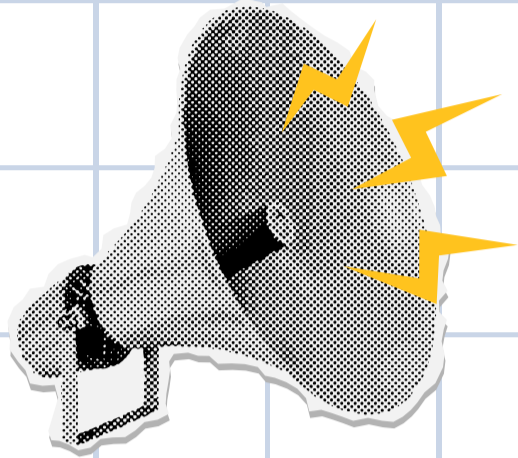
