- Performs such other duties as may be prescribed in the bylaws or assigned by the association

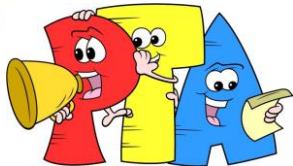

- Perform such other duties as may be delegated to the secretary

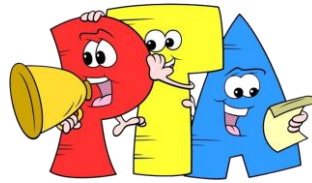

- Presents adoption reports to the association and executive board meetings.

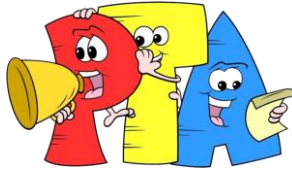

Congratulations to Mr. Meka's advisory class.

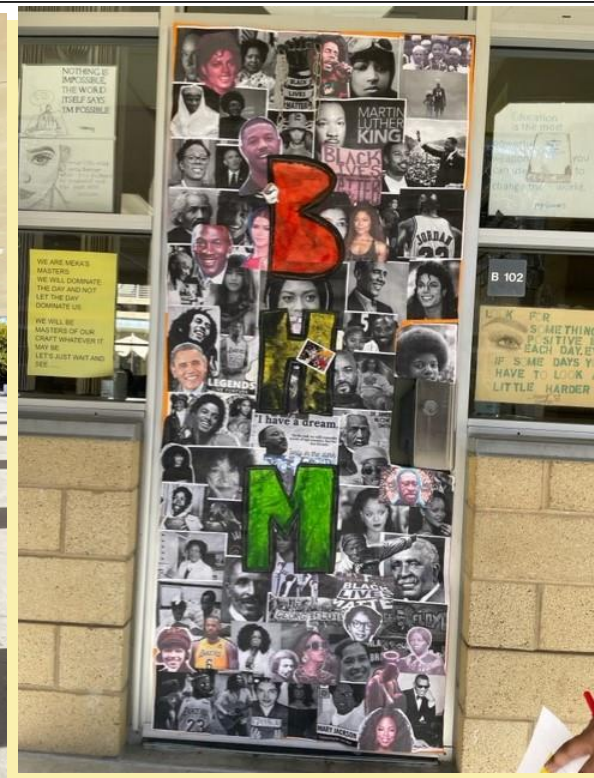
Thank you all to your participation and provided an opportunity for students to get creative and hopefully learn something new.
