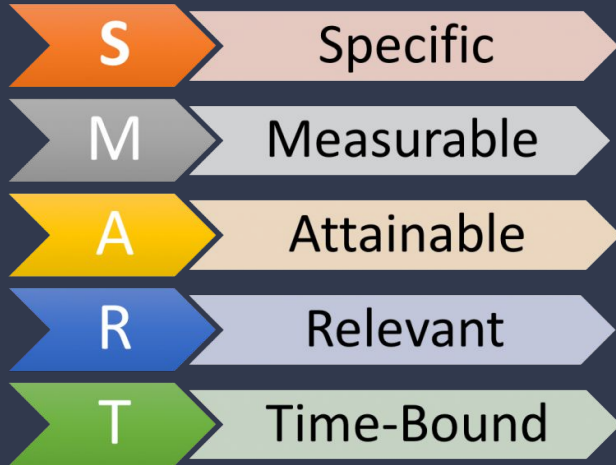

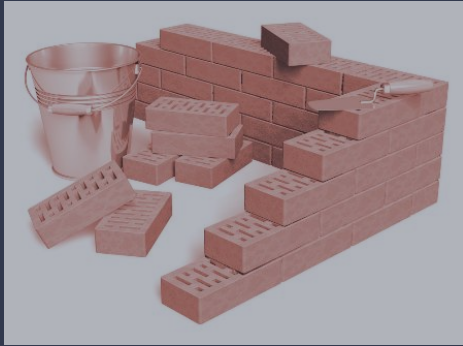

# Our Goals (2021-2022)



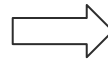
- ***Building a Culture of Community and Collaboration***
