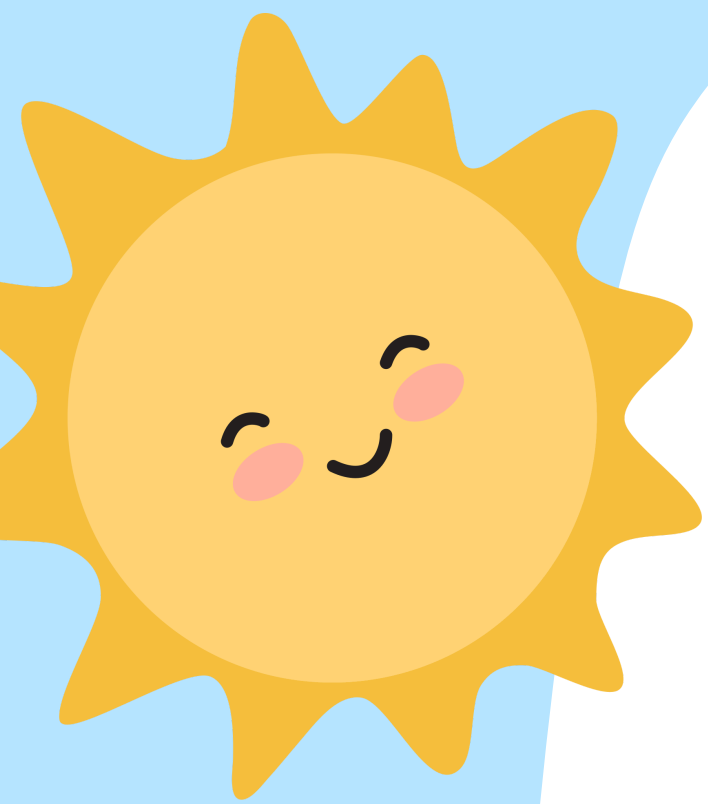

- Email submissions to preussalumni@ucsd.edu by Friday, October 18, 2024

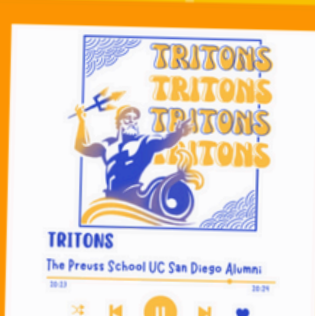


