PREUSS STUDENT SUPPORT REFERRAL PROCESS FLOW CHART

CONCERN FOR STUDENT

REFER TO SCHOOL COUNSELOR

Referrals can be from self (student), parent/guardian, teacher, administrator, school nurse and other school staff

Counselor assess concern by collecting/reviewing information from student and referral source.

SCHOOL COUNSELORS

- Academic/scheduling concerns, career planning, A-G requirements, college planning
- · Basic coping skills
- Consultation / collaboration with student, parent/guardians, and/or teachers/other school personnel
- Refer to Family Support Specialists for higher need

FAMILY SUPPORT SPECIALISTS

- Risk assessments (including follow-ups, parent calls, etc)
- McKinney Vento (unhoused/unsheltered youth)
- Foster youth
- · Food Pantry and Food Banks
- · Individual and Group Therapy
- Referral to outside community services for higher need
- Monitor well-being of students referred to/receiving support from outside community services

- If school counselors are not available:
 - Make an appt on calendly for a meeting
 - Refer to FSS only if student is in crisis/distressed:
 - crying
 - anxiety
 - depression
 - panic attacks




